Stance Sentiment Corpus

- **Motivation**: Generate a multi-label Twitter corpus with emotions. Understand which model architecture perform well. Understand interactions of emotions with sentiment and stance labels.
- **Data**: Reannotation of existing stance-Twitter corpus from SemEval 2018, approximately 4870 Tweets.
- **Method**: Corpus analysis and Application of Bag-of-words Maxent, SVM, LSTM, BiLSTM, CNN
- **Main Result**: Embeddings-based methods show higher recall than models with discrete features. Sentiment polarity labels correlated with positivity and negativity of emotions, but there are interesting outliers.
